Welcome to Code Platoon, where we are dedicated to helping members of the military community transition into the civilian workforce through technical training and career placement. Our training programs are designed specifically for Veterans, active duty Servicemembers, and military spouses. They feature immersive curriculums combined with career preparation and coaching, professional networking, and opportunities for paid apprenticeships after graduation.

Since our launch in 2016, we have graduated over 370 students into new careers in software engineering. 75% of our graduates are employed within six months of completion, with a median salary of \$86,000 within six months of graduation. After 24 months, their median salary is \$100,000.

Our Full-stack Software Engineering and DevOps and Cloud Engineering Bootcamps challenge and train students to launch successful tech careers. The curriculum features lectures, pair programming, and self-study, focusing on holistic technical and soft skills training. Students will gain hands-on experience working with today's web development tools.

Our Bootcamps are available as 15-week full-time Immersive programs or 28-week Evening and Weekend programs, providing flexibility to fit your schedule. Additionally, students may qualify for tuition through VA Education Benefits—the GI Bill, VET TEC, and VR&E (formerly Voc Rehab). We also offer a variety of scholarship options.

As part of our commitment to student success, all students in an Immersive program are eligible to participate in our apprenticeship program. The program provides a six-month paid apprenticeship with selected corporate partners, such as J.P. Morgan Chase, DRW, Grainger, Motorola Solutions, and Sprout Social. While the number of apprenticeships and corporate partners varies by cohort, the opportunity to gain real-world experience and network with industry professionals is invaluable.

Code Platoon Outcomes 2022

Every year Code, Platoon publishes data that reflects the outcomes of our program. The 2022 Outcomes Report was published in November 2022.

- One hundred sixty-eight (168) Veterans, Servicemembers, and military spouses graduated in the last two years (6 cohorts)
- One hundred twenty-six (75%) of those graduates found software engineering jobs within six months.



- The median starting salary of those graduates was \$86,000. After 24 months, the median salary increased to \$100,000.
- Of the remaining forty-two graduates, sixteen are still looking for work in technology, seventeen didn't actively look for work, and nine didn't respond to our surveys.
